Words

Each of the words below are hidden in the wordsearch above. They all have special meaning in the Bahá'i faith, so read the description of each word to find out more. Please note: they all appear as one word in the wordsearch with no punctuation.

Abdu'l Bahá - Bahá'u'lláh's eldest son and successor.

Bahá'i - one of the youngest religions in the world. Bahá'u'lláh, a founder of the Baha'i faith, saw the purpose of the religion as 'the rehabilitation of the world and its nations.'

Bahá'u'lláh - Bahá'u'lláh, which means the glory of God in Arabic, was born Mirza Husayn Ali in 1817 into one of Persia's most noble and privileged families. Bahá'u'lláh wrote a lot of the Baha'i works.

Creation - according to Baha'i belief, God created everything and creation will continue forever, although in different forms.

Fasting - a period of time (19 days) in which followers will abstain from food and drink during daylight hours.

Manifestations - different 'versions' of God appeared throughout history. Bahá'u'lláh is one of these.

Religion - the Bahá'i faith is a world religion. It is one of the youngest of the world's major religions and was founded by Bahá'u'lláh in Iran in the 19th century.

The Báb - the word 'Báb' translates into English as 'gate'. The Báb is seen as a Manifestation of God and someone who prepared the way for Bahá'u'lláh.

Tolerance - An important aspect of the Baha'i faith is tolerance and peace towards others, irrespective of differences.

Unity - Similar to tolerance, unity is a significant tenant of the Baha'i faith. Baha'is believe that ultimately the whole of humanity will be united together.
