These tables are aggregated from 1191 responses from people who completed the questionnaire with reasonable thoroughness. 134 questionnaires had been discounted for incompletion.

Results are presented in the order in which the questions arise in the questionnaire.

Young adults are those who indicated that they are between 21 and 50 years old.

Mature adults are those who indicated that they are between 51 and 70 years old. Older adults are those who indicated that they are over 70 years old.
